SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID AVAILABLE

FEDERAL

Federal Teach Grant

- Top 25 percent ACT/SAT or maintain a 3.25 college GPA
- Agree to teach four out of eight years at a low-income school in a high-need field.
- Grant converts to loan if services requirements not met.
- Up to \$4,000; Aggregate maximum of \$16,000

Federal Teacher Loan Forgiveness**

- Teach for five consecutive years at a school where more than 30 percent of students qualify for Title 1 services.
- Must be considered highly qualified.
- Federal loans forgiven up to: \$17,500 for teaching STEM or Special Education; \$5,000 for all other subject areas

Federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness

- Work full-time for a public entity or not for profit;
- Make 120 payments under a qualified payment plan.
- Remaining federal loans are waived; No maximum amount

STATE

Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship (NGHES)

- Top 20 percent ACT/SAT or top 20 percent graduating class
- Maintain a 3.0 college GPA
- Teach for 5 consecutive years in an eligible school
- \$7,500 per year

Minority Teacher Scholarship*

- Black or Hispanic; College GPA required to enter school of education (2.00 if no GPA requirement for entry)
- Up to \$4,000 for students with need
- Up to \$1,000 for students without need

Student Teaching Stipend for Minorities*

- Black or Hispanic; College GPA required to enter school of education (2.00 if no GPA requirement for entry)
- Up to \$4,000

Student Teaching Stipend for High-Need Fields

- Black or Hispanic; College GPA required to enter school of education (2.00 if no GPA requirement for entry)
- Up to \$4,000
